Thursday 14th

Morfa Nefyn on the Llyn peninsula is home to one of the most photographed holes in the country and we will play the promontory back 9. Visit http://www.nefyn-golf-club.co.uk/en/ to be bowled over

Meet for lunch and 1st tee at 2:00pm.

Golf buggy = £25

We will then drive some 30 miles to The Bulkeley Hotel in Beaumaris, Anglesey for our evening meal in the hotel. You can read more at https://www.bulkeleyhotel.co.uk/

Friday 15th

After breakfast we make our way to Bull Bay, some 18 miles north of Beaumaris. This course was designed by Herbert Fowler who, for those that may have played in Epsom, designed the Old Course at the RAC. This course is right on the coast and factoring in the wind is crucial – take plenty of balls. Have a look at http://www.bullbaygc.co.uk/ to be blown away! 1st tee at 11:32am.

Back to Beaumaris and the evening meal is once again at The Bulkeley Hotel.

Saturday 16th

Breakfast, then only a short distance from our hotel is the wonderful Henllys Hall, a course I play at least a couple of times a year. The views across the Menai Straits are breathtaking – especially those from the 5th tee, the highest point on the course. Get a taste at http://www.henllysgolfclub.co.uk/

1st tee at 11:30am Golf buggy = £20

Afternoon tea, after everyone back safely in the clubhouse.

For non-golfers, Beaumaris is of historic interest. Visit the castle or relax and enjoy the scenery. Nearby coastal paths enable the more adventurous to explore the wildlife and appreciate the beauty of the coastline. Snowdonia is not too far away and the forest at Newborough is worth a visit.
